When Godzilla rampaged through the streets of Tokyo, the Japanese would tell you that size definitely matters. And we'd attest to that statement too after spending some quality time with this behemoth of a speaker set.

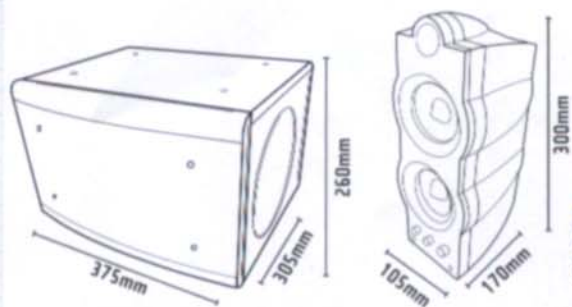
Most sound systems, even the crappy ones, come with a standard subwoofer box. But compared to the Ultra A7, the other woofers would be quaking in their boots and shrivel into a corner. With 85W of raw power sprucing up its two main speakers alongside its **55W RMS High Excursion Dedicated Ultra Low Bass**, this will generate immersive booms worthy of its end-of-the-world title.

Ever heard the mantra of 'all things beautiful living in harmony'? On one end (below the table) we've got some mind-blowing bass. At the other end, the Ultra A7 smartly balances it with sharp, clear trebles thanks to the pair of **silk-lined domed tweeters** that come bundled with the gargantuan beast. Although, you will need to practice discretion when tuning the treble against the bass unit as the box under the table tends to be overpowering slightly.



Mass issues aside, the buffed-up A7 is elegantly crafted for its looks too – with it being part aluminium, part wood, part glossy plastic. The matt-aluminium exterior of the subwoofer also gives off a **premium finishing** to the boom box while its innards are lined quaintly with wood finishing for exquisite full-bodied audio fidelity.

Although we'd term this a very decent set of speakers, it still **lacks a few fancy features** that would normally wet our pants. The mini thrill of a remote control or blinky LED display would do it wonders. But for what it's worth, the space-bender sticks true to its core purpose, and that's to bring an end to the world with crushing loud sounds.
